

Enable Email Authentication On Android Compatible Device (Using Android Ver. 4)

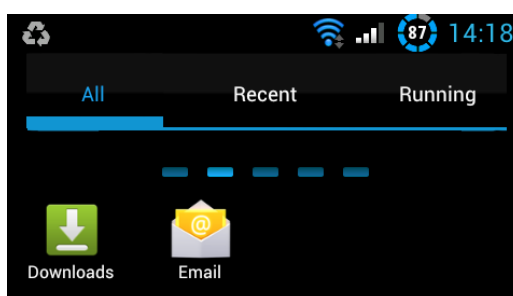
What Is Email Authentication?

Email authentication is a wide set of other tools used by email senders and receivers to establish sender reputation. All major ISP's like Hotmail, Gmai , AOL, use email authentication to filter out suspected spam emails.

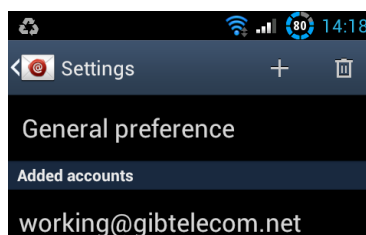

Please note that in this example Gibtelecom are using a Samsung Galaxy SII Smartphone

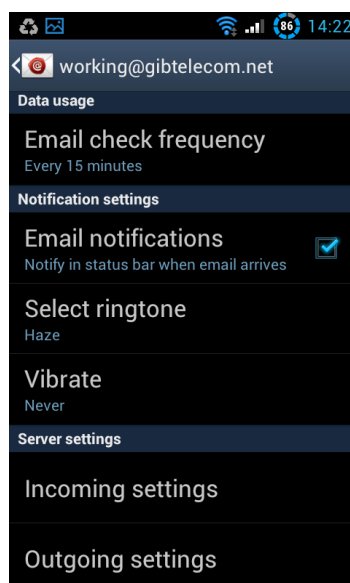
1. Go into your Apps Menu and select **EMAIL**



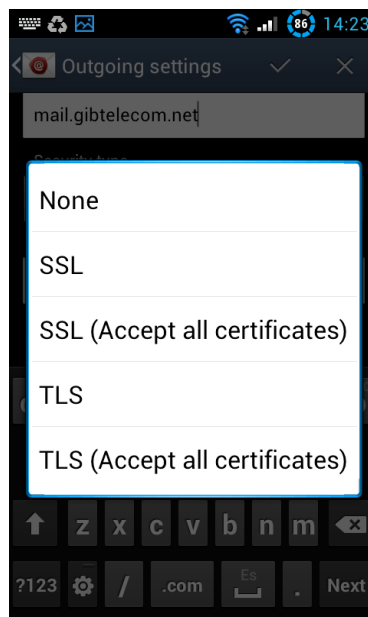
2. Once your email application is opened, select **SETTINGS** and then choose your Gibtelecom Email Account



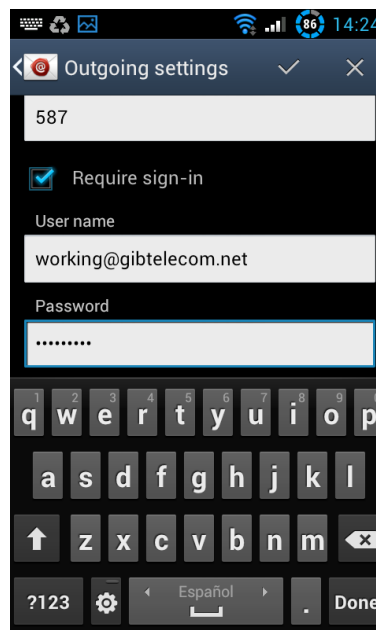
3. Scroll down to **Server Settings** and choose **Outgoing Settings**,



4. Select **Security Type** and choose **TLS**



5. Enable to option **Require Sign-In** and enter your username (which is your email address) and your password.



Enabling Email Authentication for outgoing emails has now been completed so you can return to your home screen.
